

Concurrent Enrollment

A new application for Concurrent Enrollment must be submitted each semester. The program is available to high school junior and senior level students subject to the following provisions:

1. The student must meet the Freshman Admissions requirements for A&M-Texarkana.
2. The student must have the approval of his/her parent/guardian and high school counselor/principal.
3. The student must complete and submit an Application for Admissions to A&M-Texarkana. (You may apply online at www.applytexas.org.)
4. The student must document that they have satisfied the Texas Success Initiative (TSI) requirements. If the student has not satisfied TSI, the student is not eligible for enrollment with A&M-Texarkana. Students may not enroll in remediation courses as concurrent students.
5. The student must submit an up-to-date official high school transcript.
6. An official high school transcript showing the graduation date should be sent to A&M-Texarkana as soon as it is available. Official university transcripts will be available once a final high school transcript is received. If an A&M-Texarkana transcript is required prior to graduation, the student should contact Admissions. The student's signature below authorizes the high school to release high school transcripts to A&M-Texarkana as needed.
7. The student must maintain at least a 2.0 cumulative grade point average at A&M-Texarkana to continue in the concurrent enrollment program.
8. If the student is enrolled with another institution while enrolled in the concurrent enrollment program at A&M-Texarkana, the student must request official final transcripts be sent to A&M-Texarkana by the issuing institution(s).
9. The student will register for classes and pay all regular tuition and fees during the regular registration period and as an A&M-Texarkana student will be responsible for observing all University regulations.

State law requires that you will be informed of the following: 1) you are entitled to request to be informed about the information about yourself collected by use of the form (with a few exceptions as provided by law); 2) you are entitled to receive and review that information; and 3) you are entitled to have the information corrected at no charge to you.
