Construction on the Multi-Purpose Library Building is on Schedule...

Construction work is progressing nicely at the Main Campus. The Multipurpose Library Building, the second building to be built at the new campus, is expected to be “topped out” in July. The four level, 183,000 square foot building, will house most of the university’s operations when it opens next year in time for the fall 2010 semester. The 375 acre campus is being built on the city’s north side, about five miles from the existing campus, in order to accommodate future growth. The university will downwardly expand next year in order to accept freshman and sophomore students. University officials are currently in the development stages of putting together a plan to provide student housing, which will allow the university to expand its recruiting effort.



In addition to the Multipurpose Library being under construction, the Physical Plant building is also being built in the same general vicinity. This building will house the university’s security office and provide the infrastructure for the heating and cooling systems at the campus. The Science & Technology Building, a 42,000 square foot three story building, was completed in 2008. The building hosts the biology, computer science and engineering disciplines.
