NOTE: The following items constitute a *graduate program application packet*. The *packet* must be submitted to the Graduate Studies Office by the designated deadline of the first semester of enrollment as a degree seeking student. Further enrollment will be contingent on completion. All documents should be submitted in original/hard copy format...no emails or faxes.

PROGRAM APPLICATION CRITERIA

- **A baccalaureate degree**
 - Transcripts must be sent directly to the Admissions Office from schools attended
- **Undergraduate GPA score required**
 - Minimum of 2.5 in last 60 hours of undergraduate degree program required
- **Three positive letters of academic recommendation**
 - Letters must be current and dated within 6 months of application
- **A positive record of life and professional experiences**
- **A letter of interest and commitment**
- **Official scores on the GRE**
 - Sent by the Educational Testing Service (ETS) to Texas A&M University-Texarkana
 - The scores for the analytical, verbal, and quantitative components are required
 - Scores may be no older than 5 years at the time of application
 - Applicants seeking a 2nd master's degree are exempt from this requirement if overall graduate GPA is a minimum of 3.0
