

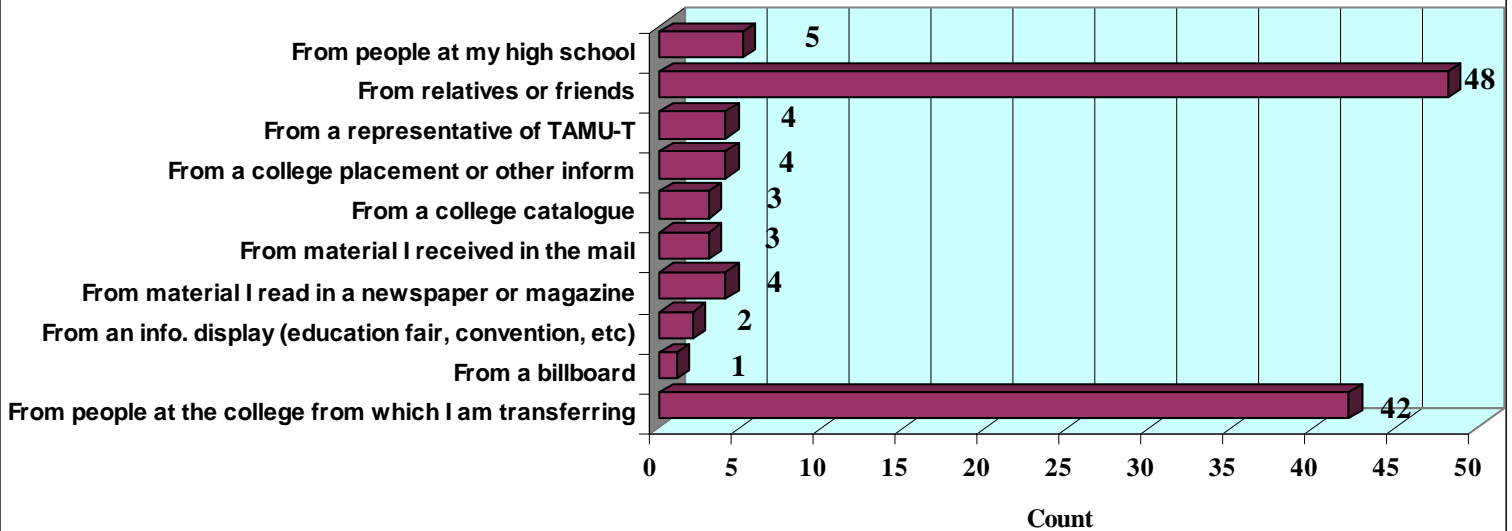

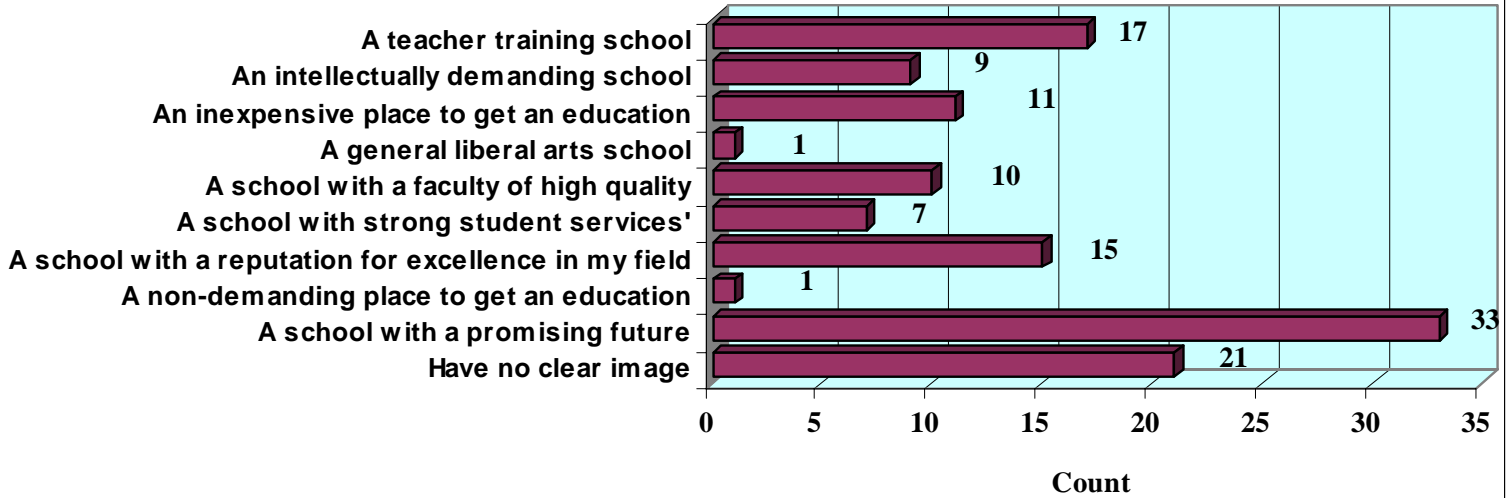

What image do you have of TAMU-T?

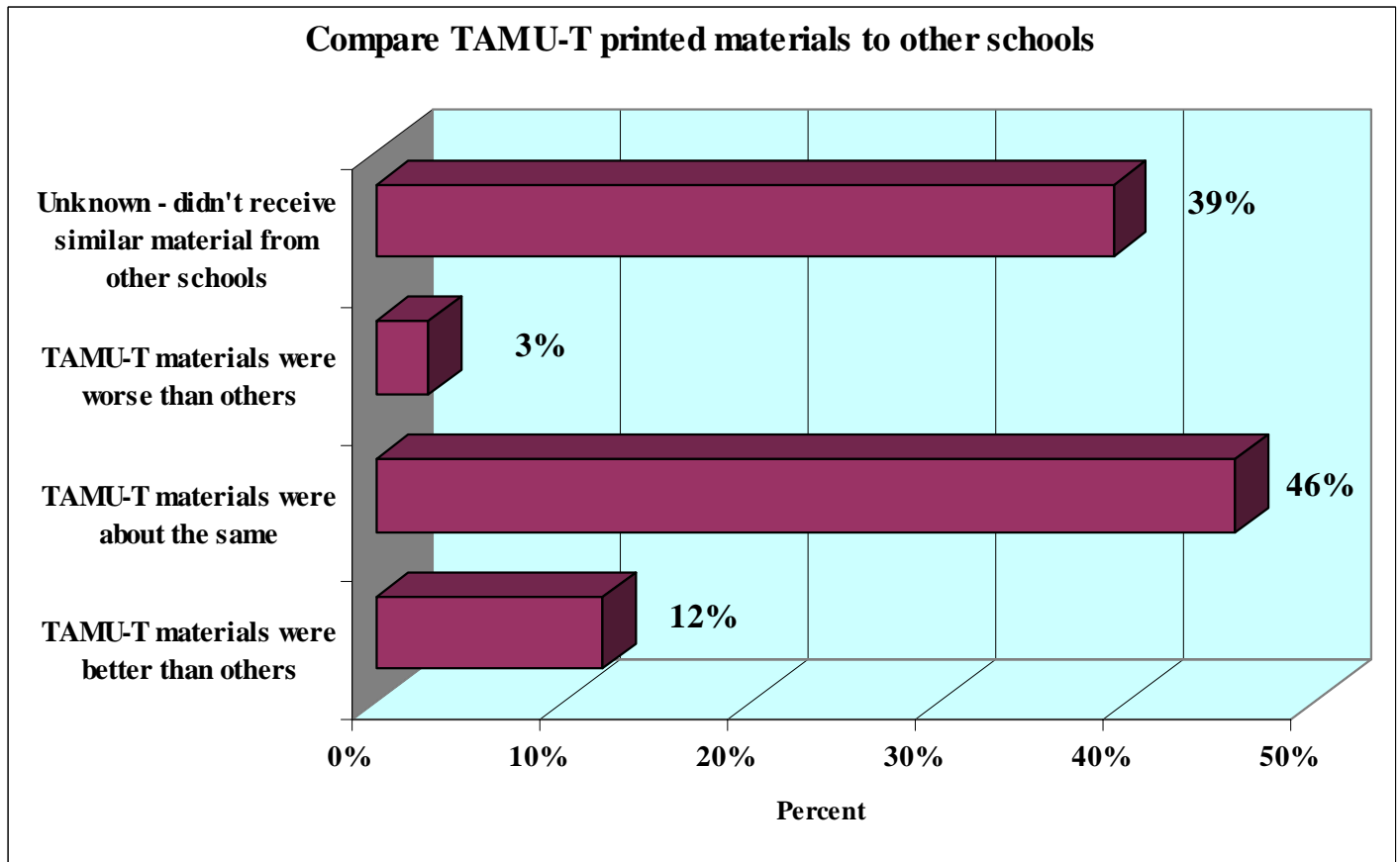

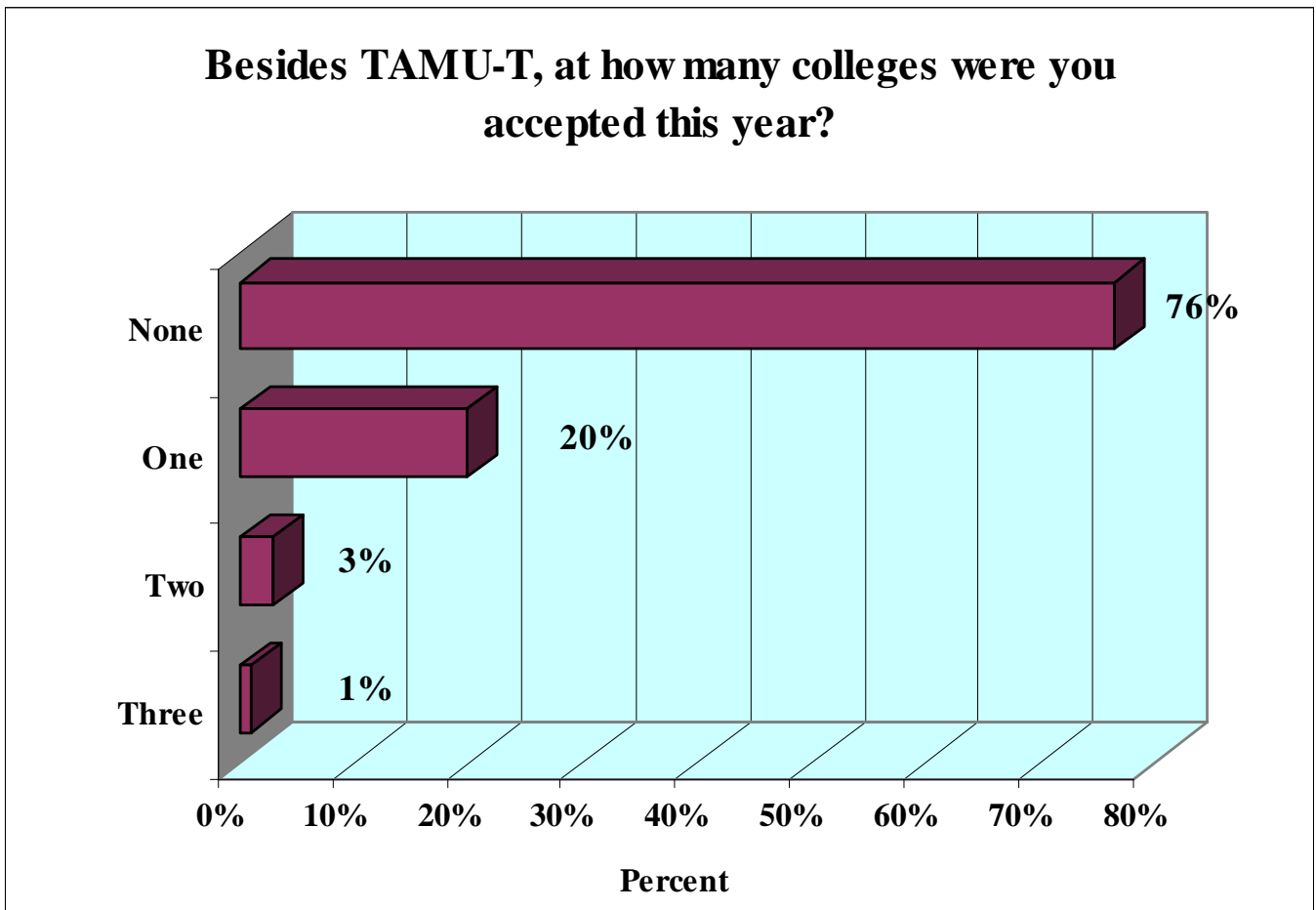

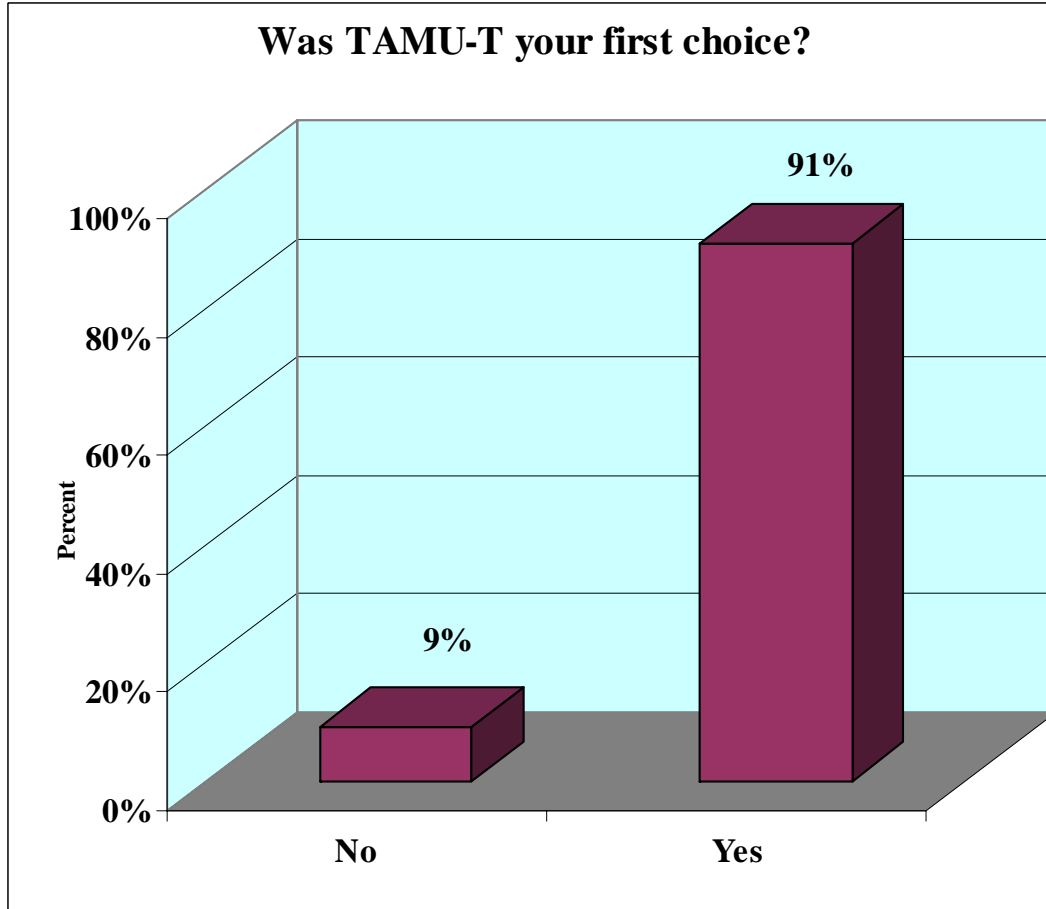

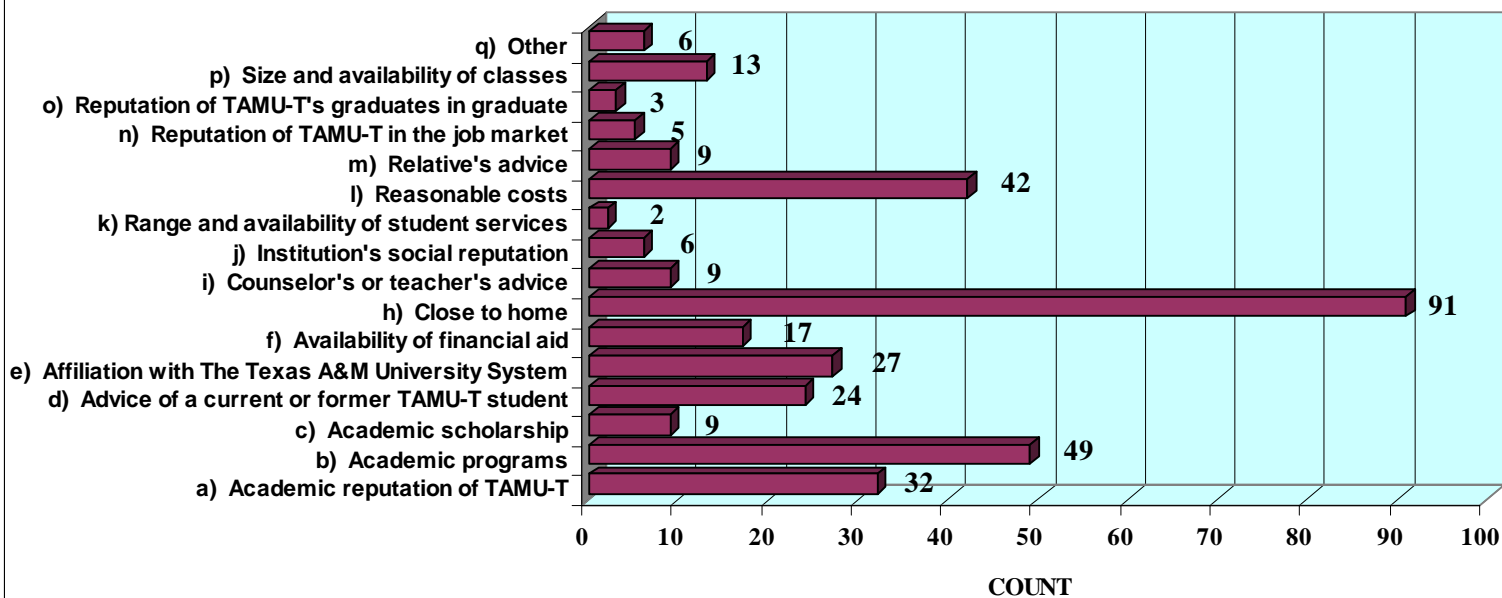

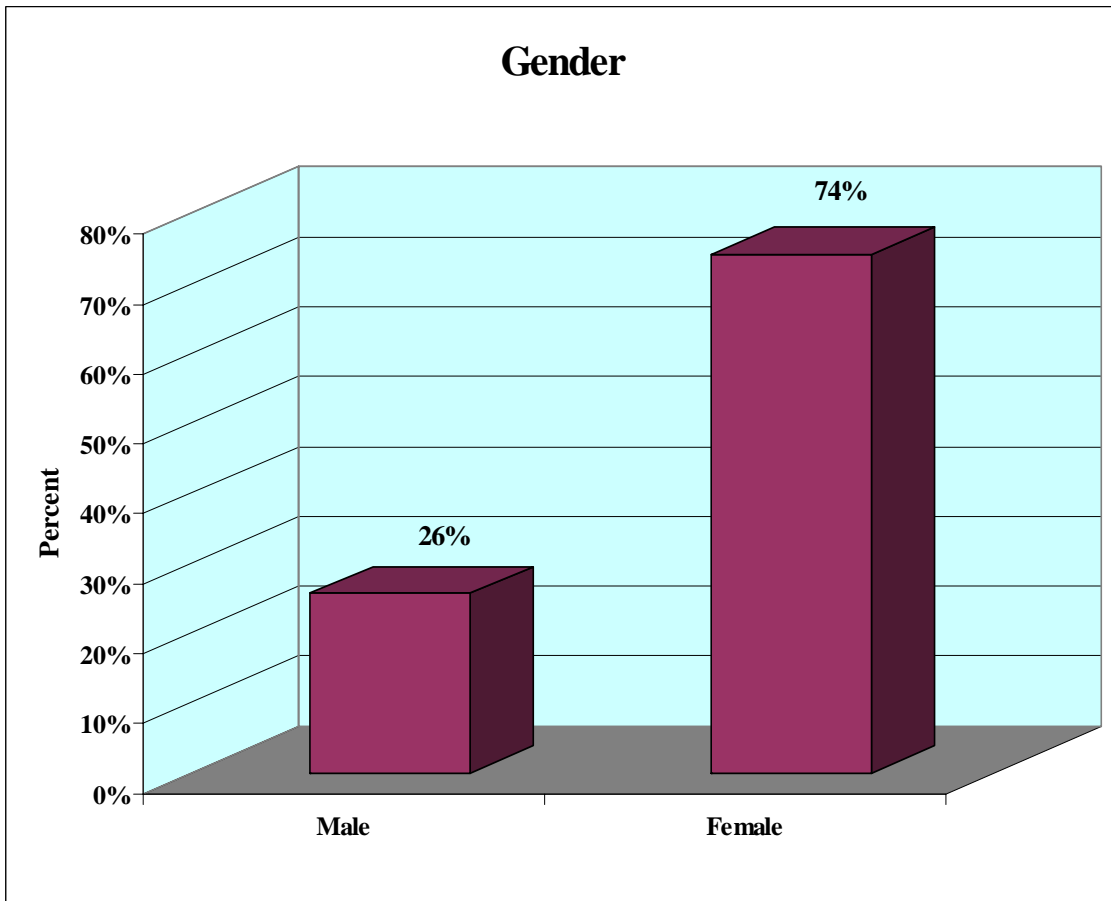

Highest level of education completed by mother

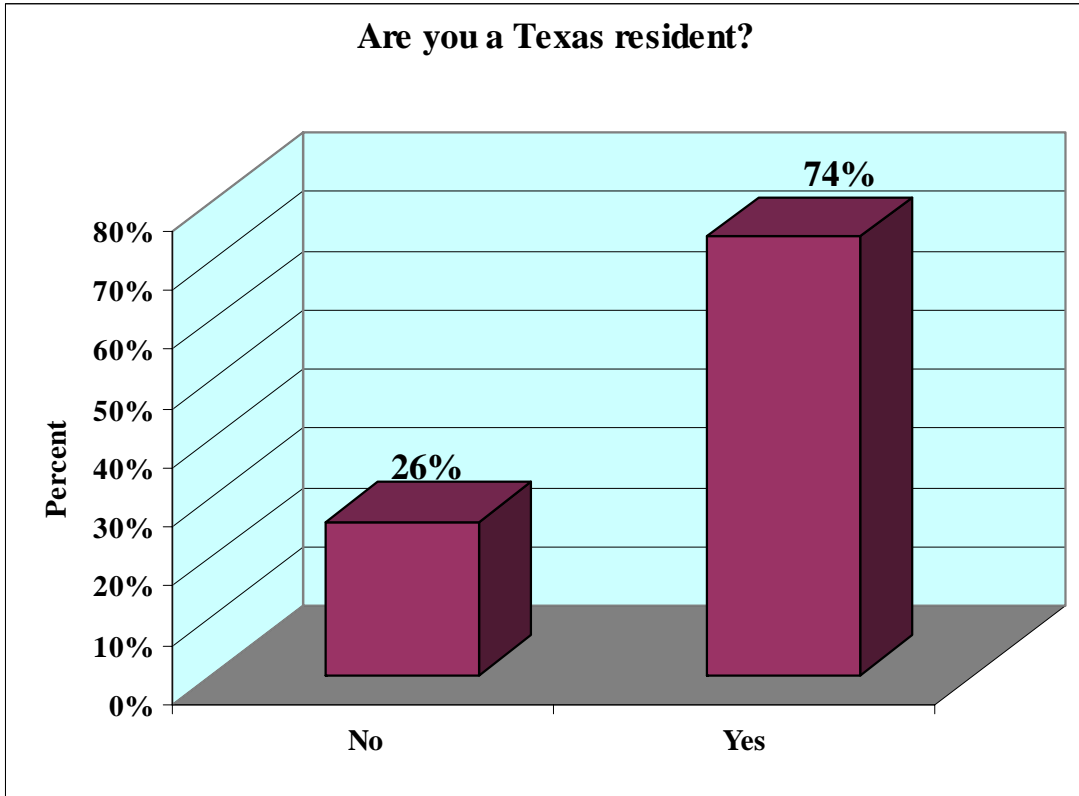

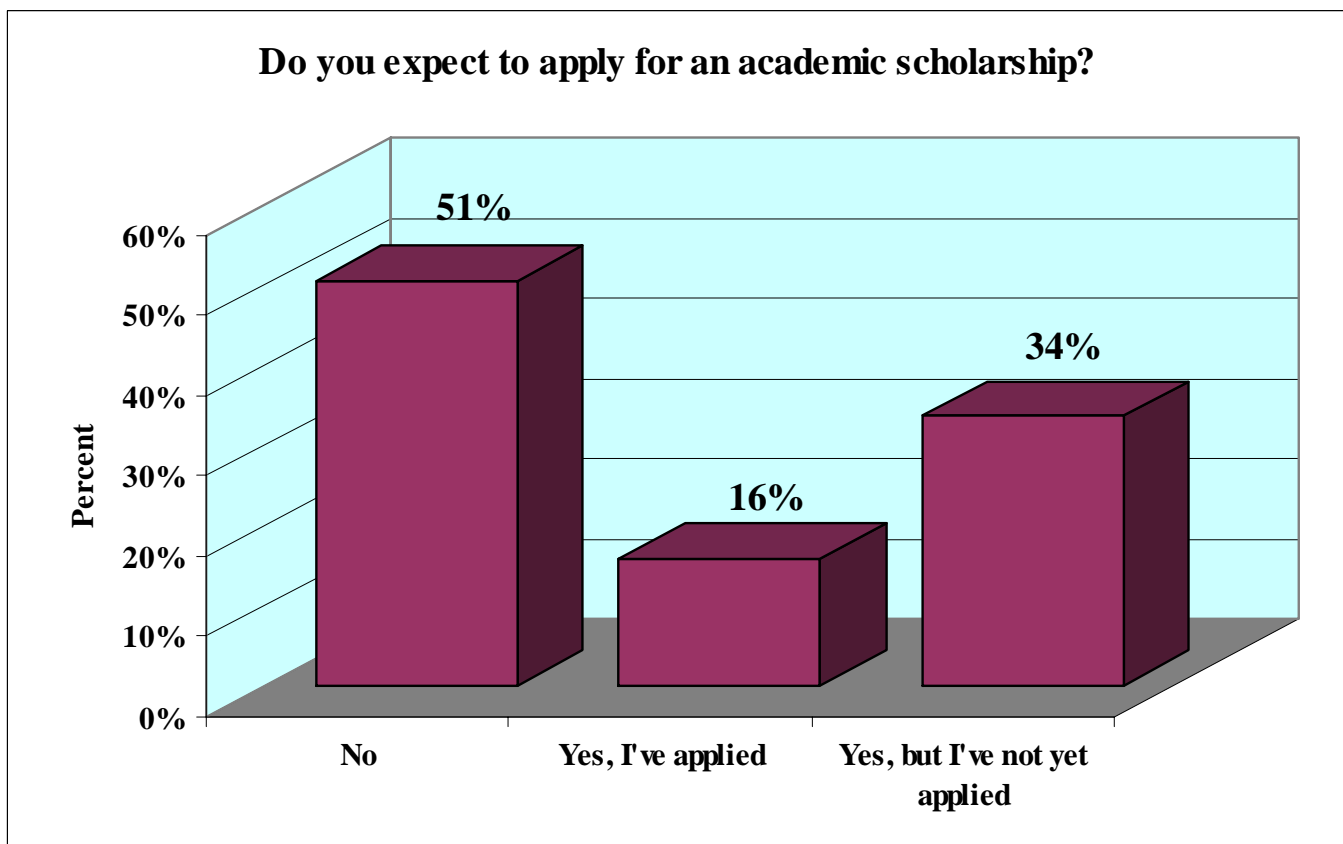

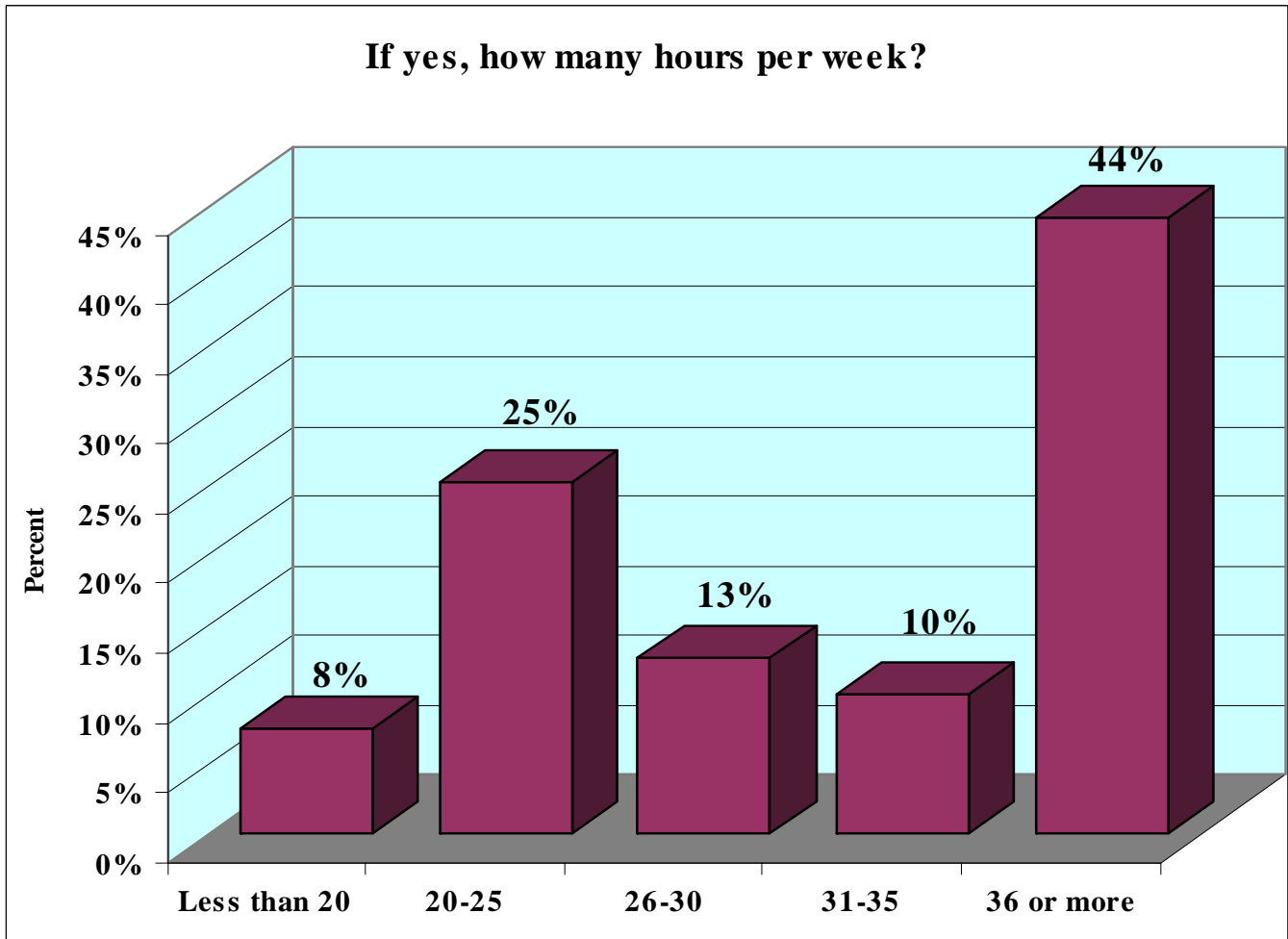
