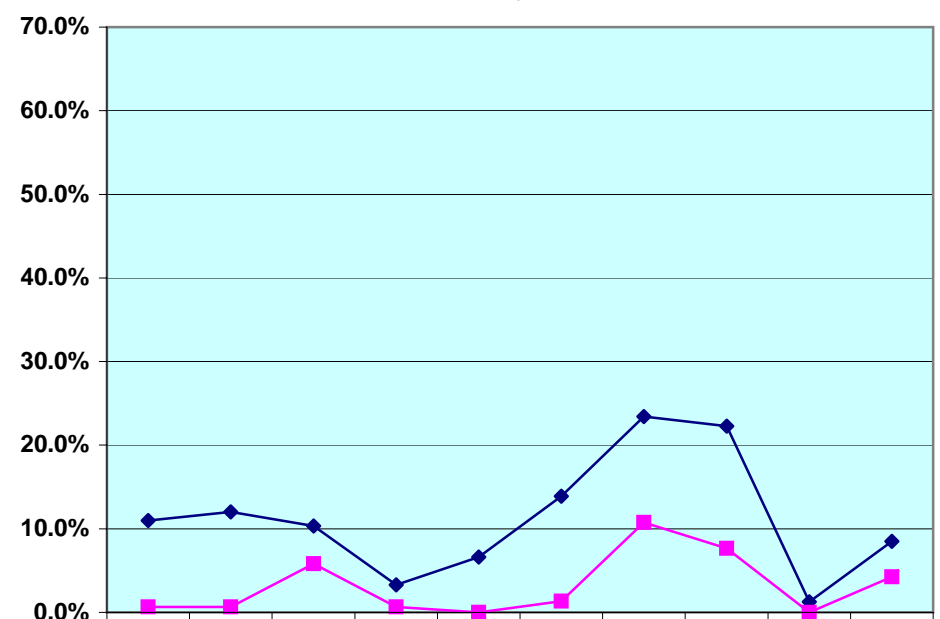

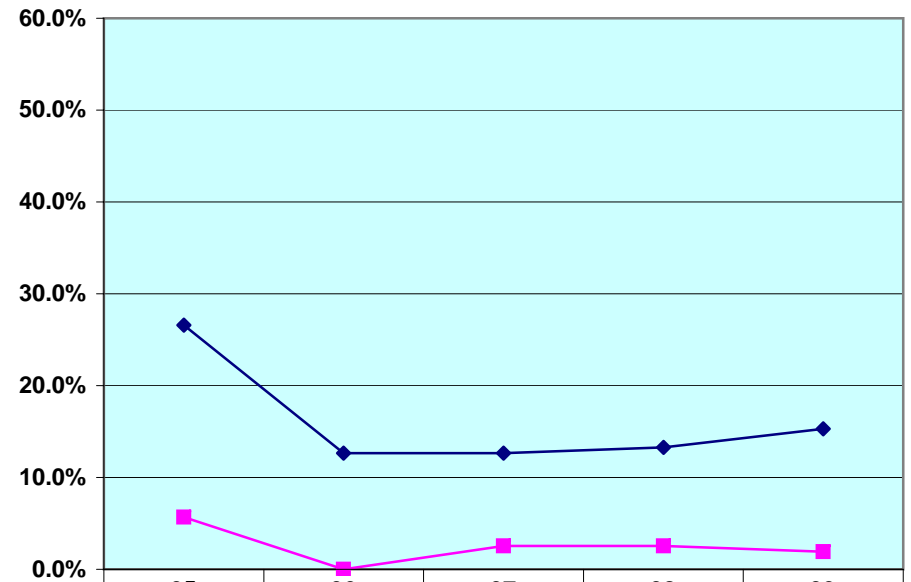

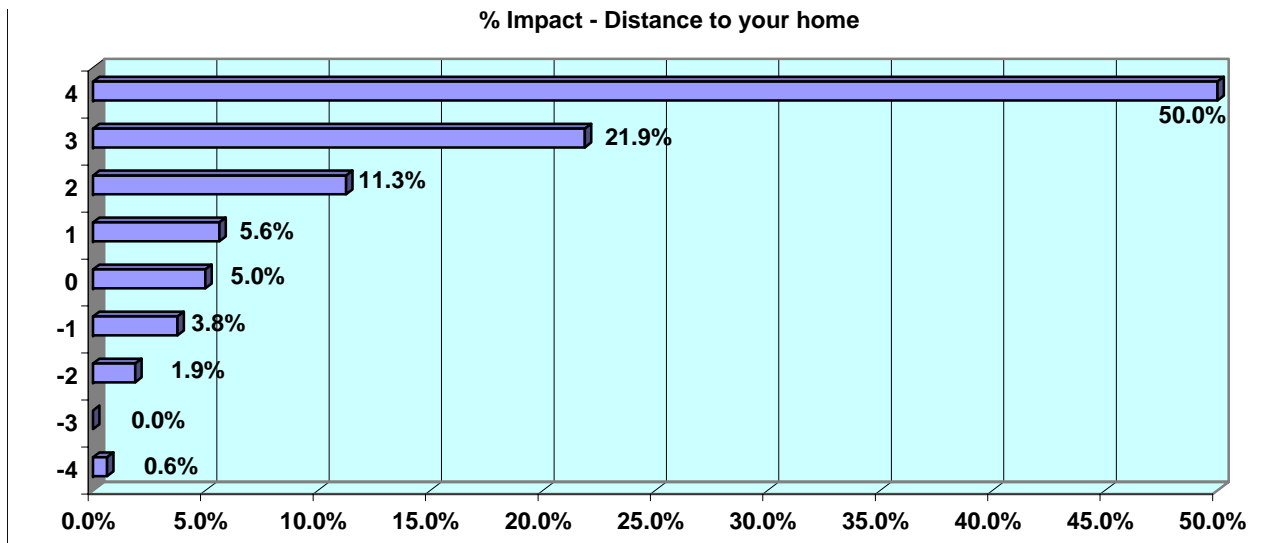


% Impact - Distance to your home

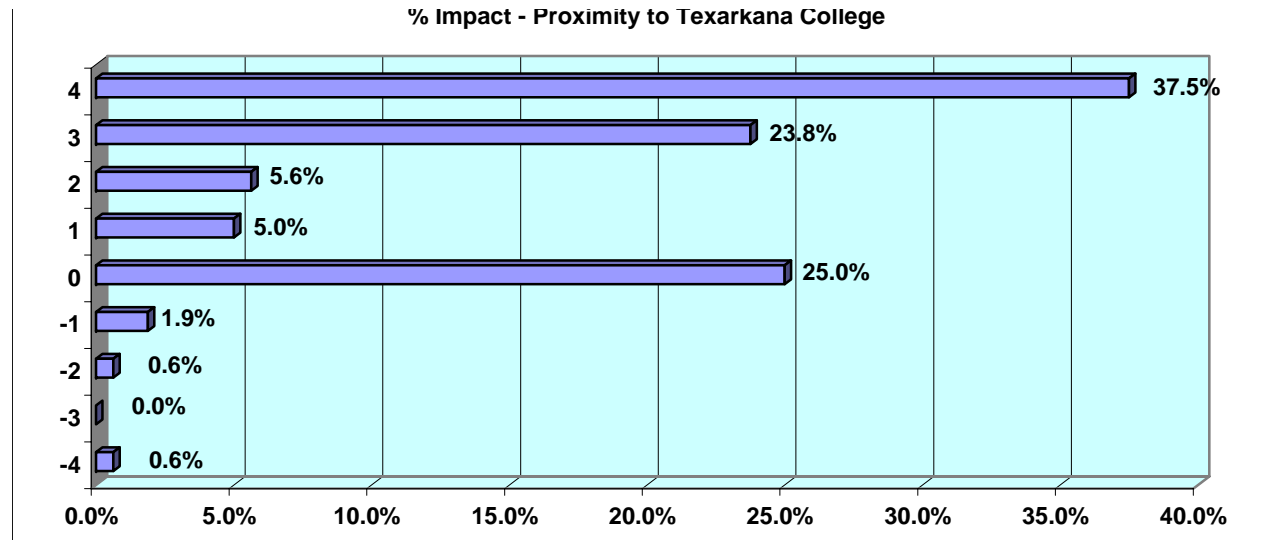


% Impact - Proximity to Texarkana College

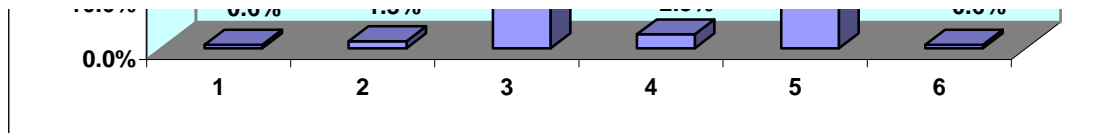
