**TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

1. Pass all three parts of the THEA or TASP. **Reading 240 - Math 230 - Writing 220**
2. Attend the Teacher Preparation Orientation during first semester of enrollment.
3. Achieve cumulative 2.60 GPA
4. Meet with faculty advisor during first semester of enrollment.

Note: Bachelor's degree graduation requirements include these minimums: 60 SCH transfer credit, 54sh upper-division credit, and resident credit totaling 25% of the hours required for the degree.
