



Instructions for Wi-Fi Use:

- The campus Wi-Fi is Eagle WiFi. You should see this in your device settings or computer network settings as an available Wi-Fi network.
- Select Eagle WiFi, agree to the terms and conditions, and select your access type. You can select from "Student, Faculty, and Staff Access" or "Guest Access".
- Students and employees enter their NetID username and password. Mobile users may have to download a profile onto their device.
- Guests Enter a cell phone number capable of receiving text messages. A code will be sent by text message to your phone. Enter this into your device to connect.
- Connections will remain valid for up to one year. In the future, if you are not connected automatically, it may be necessary to turn on WiFi and select Eagle WiFi.

Instructions for Computer Use:

- There are computers available for student use in the library and the computer labs. Use of these computers requires sign in.
- Log into the TAMUT domain.
- Enter your user name and password. Your username is the first four letters of your last name plus the last four digits of your Campus-wide ID. Also carefully enter your password.
- Be sure to log off computers when you finish using them. Leaving a computer logged in leaves your and other people's data vulnerable and is a security violation which could result in loss of computer privileges.
