# 11.02.01.H1.01 Periodic Assessment of Centers and Institutes

## **Procedure Summary**

As a member of the Texas A&M University System, Texas A&M University – Texarkana may create centers or institutes to provide structure to interdisciplinary collaborative efforts that span various academic departments or units or intercollegiate or interagency activities, as provided for in <u>System Policy 11.02</u>, <u>Creation of Centers and Institutes</u>. A&M – Texarkana is required to implement processes to ensure any centers or institutes comply with the requirements of the Policy through ongoing monitoring and periodic review. <u>System Regulation 11.02.01</u>, <u>Management and Evaluation of Centers and Institutes</u> outlines the requirements of this ongoing monitoring and periodic review to outline the responsibilities at A&M-Texarkana to fulfill these requirements.

## **Procedures and Responsibilities**

At which time that A&M – Texarkana establishes a center or institute that has been recommended by the chancellor and approved by the Board of Regents, the director of such center or institute is charged with providing a report on the center or institute's operations during the review period to account for the governance and oversight, fiscal operations and budget, funding sources, and research and/or education activities.

- 1. REVIEW COMMITTEE
  - 1.1 The center or institute's designated director, at the direction of and with approval of the Provost, may establish a review committee to conduct the period review.
  - 1.2 The review committee size shall be determined jointly by the director and the Provost, as appropriate for the center or institute, but must include at least one external reviewer.
  - 1.3 The committee is tasked with reviewing the director's report, evaluating the performance of the center or institute, and submitting a report to the Provost documenting this review and assessing whether the center or institute should continue, be modified, or dissolved.
  - 1.4 This periodic review must occur at least once every five years on a schedule developed by the center or institute's director. Newly developed centers should conduct a review annually for at least the first three years of existence and then on the fifth year before moving to a five year cycle.

#### 2. PERIODIC REVIEW ASSESSMENT ELEMENTS

The periodic review shall, at a minimum, address the questions outlined in the appendix of <u>System Regulation 11.02.01</u>, <u>Management and Evaluation of Centers</u> <u>and Institutes</u>.

#### 3. REPORTING

The Committee shall prepare a report of their assessment and provide it to the Provost. The Provost will provide a written report to the President. This report will then be submitted to the System Office of Academic Affairs and System Office of Research as required in <u>System Regulation 11.02.01</u>, *Management and Evaluation of Centers and Institutes*.
